We played a basketball game that includes both boys and girls in order to **empower gender balance** in several ways as :

- Equal Participation, that both genders have equal opportunities to participate, breaking down traditional gender barriers in sports.

Why we played basketball with different rules ?

How was our basketball with different rules ?



- 1. We were Mixed Teams Sometimes we were (1 boy 4 girls), (2 boys and 3 girls), than (3 boys and 2 girls).
- 2. We rotate the roles, between us in order that everyone gets to experience different position of the game.
- 3. Each one of us have to tuch the ball before scoring a point.
- 4. Before making a point teams must complete 10 passes inside their team.
- 5. Only girls can score.
- 6. If you are a girl you have to pass the ball to a different gender (to a boy).
- 7. Five Seconds Rule: Players can only hold the ball for a maximum of five seconds before passing.
- 8. Each player must Dribble the ball not more than 2 times

These rules can make the game more inclusive and encourage collaboration, communication and GENDER BALANCE .

The basketball game with different rules we played was a genderbalanced game where a game created by us only to have FUN and promote gender equality.
