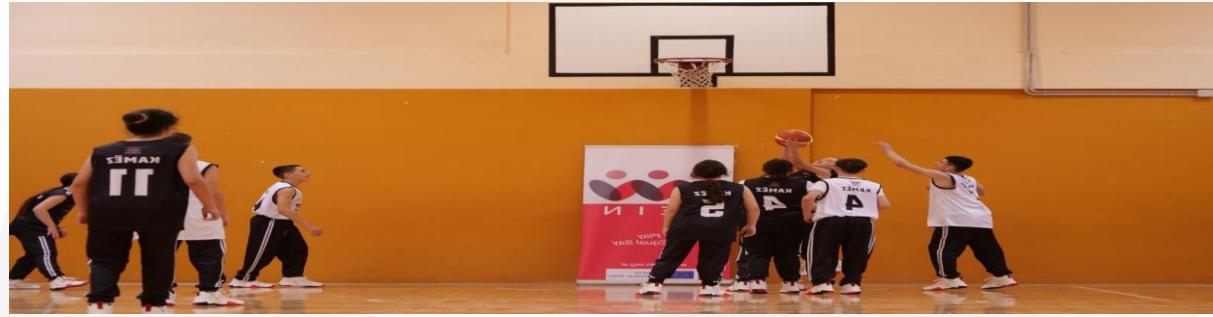

What we did:



We played a basketball game that includes both boys and girls in order to **empower gender balance** in several ways as :

- **Equal Participation**, that both genders have equal opportunities to participate, breaking down traditional gender barriers in sports.
- **To have a great teamwork and collaboration**, because when we play together we have more fun and build mutual respect.
- Boys and girls learn to rely on each other's strengths and work towards a common goal.



Why we played basketball with different rules ?

- Because in this way we challenge gender stereotypes by focusing only on physical skills regardless of gender.
- We also building confidence , specially for girls while playing alongside boys can boost confidence and encourage them to pursue sports more actively.
- When we play together boys with girls we raises awareness about gender equality in very easy way which can influence also other people that see and hear about this match.

How was our basketball with different rules ?

1. We were Mixed Teams - Sometimes we were (1 boy 4 girls), (2 boys and 3 girls), than (3 boys and 2 girls).
2. We rotate the roles, between us in order that everyone gets to experience different position of the game.
3. Each one of us have to tuch the ball before scoring a point.
4. Before making a point teams must complete 10 passes inside their team.
5. Only girls can score.
6. If you are a girl you have to pass the ball to a different gender (to a boy).
7. Five Seconds Rule: Players can only hold the ball for a maximum of five seconds before passing.
8. Each player must Dribble the ball not more than 2 times

These rules can make the game more inclusive and encourage collaboration, communication and GENDER BALANCE .

In conclusion :

The basketball game with different rules we played was a gender-balanced game where a game created by us only to have FUN and promote gender equality.

This inclusive game helped us to **break down stereotypes**,
